Overview

Detailed configuration for LAV Splitter - a source/splitter filter to demux video files into their separate elementary streams.

LAV Splitter Settings

In Configuration > [Codecs and Renderer](#), click on the screwdriver icon next to the LAV Splitter (Source) to display the following settings screen:

Note: You must enable **Source Splitter Selection** before you can select detailed settings for LAV Splitter

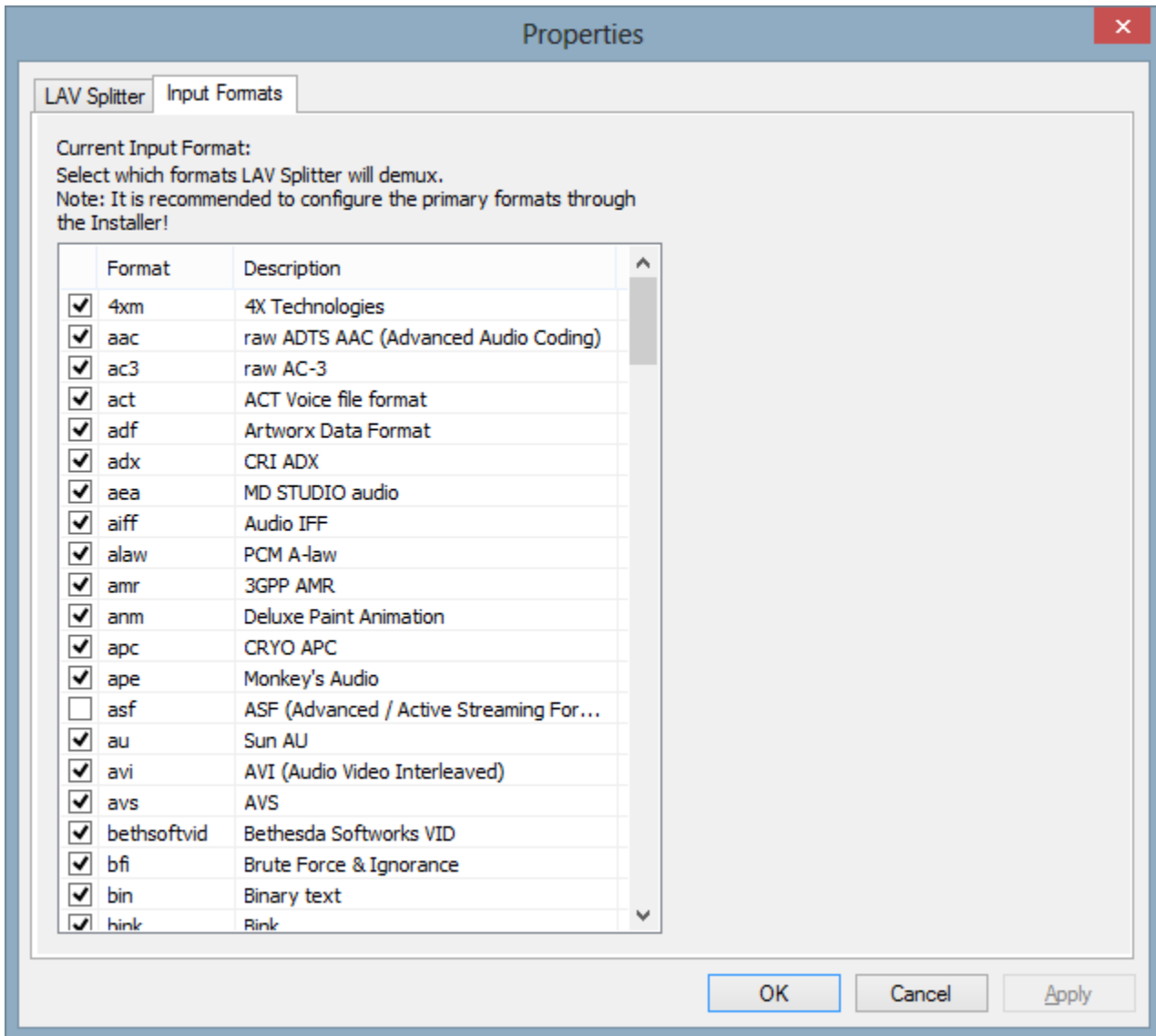
- Preferred Languages:** Enter your preferred languages as their 3-letter language codes, comma separated. (Example: "eng,ger,fre")
